

CHANGING AND SHOWERING POLICY

Mersey Rose Recreationals Cricket Club is committed to adhering to the best practice principles of the ECB.

- Adults must not change or shower at the same time using the same facility as children.
- Adults should try to change at separate times to children.
- If children play for adult teams, they, and their parents, must be informed of the Club's policy on changing arrangements.
- If anyone is uncomfortable changing or showering at the Club, or at any facilities the club visits for the purposes of playing cricket, no pressure should be put on them to do so. In these cases, it should be suggested that he/she/they should change and shower at home.
- Mobile phones MUST NOT be used in changing rooms due to the risk of inappropriate photography or filming
- Separate facilities should be used for male and female players. Where there are no separate changing facilities, the Club will provide separate times for use of the changing rooms by males and females on match/training days.
- It is the intention of the Club to implement this policy at away matches where practicable.
