MISSION STATEMENT

The club aims to:

1. Provide a safe and inclusive space for all people, irrespective of age, ability, races, religion, gender or sexual orientation, to fully participate in sport and experience a sense of belonging.
2. Offer the opportunity to enjoy cricket in a welcoming, supportive and non-pressurised environment.
3. Become a movement for inclusion, helping to create a world where equality and inclusion are realities rather than aspirations. We will work with other sports clubs and bodies (where possible) to achieve inclusive outcomes.
4. Promote disability inclusion by offering suitable opportunities for disabled people to be involved in the full life of the club.
5. Promote friendly cricket as a vehicle for inclusion and community development
6. Work to create a friendly cricket “scene” or network that is vibrant, welcoming, supportive, inclusive, creative and forward-thinking.
7. Ensure that all 22 people involved in a game of cricket (plus umpires and scorers) have an enjoyable time.
8. Use cricket as a means of promoting good physical and mental well-being.
9. Promote participation over competitiveness.
